CALL TO ORDER

BE IT REMEMBERED that, on the above date, the City Council of the City of Alvin, Texas, met in Workshop Session at 6:00 P.M. in the first floor conference room at City Hall, with the following members present: Mayor Paul A. WORKSHOP ITEM

Discuss aiding in infrastructure improvements in other governmental jurisdictions.

Ramiro Mondragon, City Council member for Hillcrest Village, addressed the Council requesting financial assistance from Alvin to help pay for half the cost of the material to pave a portion of Fairway Drive that is owned by Hillcrest Village. He explained that there are residents that are in the Alvin city limits that front Fairway Drive. The work will be done by Brazoria County Commissioner Precinct 3 Stacy Adams' office.

Suzanne Hanneman, Interim City Attorney, explained that the City of Alvin does not have control over the road way; therefore, Alvin could not enter into a memorandum of understanding. However, City Council could vote to expend the money, if they so choose. She explained the historical background of the annexation and de-annexation of the area.

This item was referred to the June 15th Council meeting for consideration to pay for half the cost of the materials (\$30,075) in the amount of \$15,537.50.
