WORKSHOP ITEMS:

Discuss and consider the proposed amendments to the City Charter of the City of Alvin, Texas and take appropriate action.

The 2020 Charter Review Report was presented to City Council on December 17, 2020. The City Council and members of the Charter Review Commission reviewed this Report in its entirety, discussing the rationale behind the recommendations made. Discussion was had on the proposed changes. City Council agreed to submit the proposed changes to a vote of the people in a Special Charter Election to be called for May 1, 2021. The City Attorney will work with the City Secretary to draft an ordinance calling a special election for City Council's consideration. This election must be called by the governing body no later than February 12, 2021, as prescribed by the State of Texas Election Code.
